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Could you please clarify why under section 6.1.1 Key experts it is required at Specific experience for Key expert 1: <b>Team Leader</b> and Key Expert 2: <b>FIDIC Engineer - Deputy Team Leader</b> that both experts need to have relevant experience <i>"under FIDIC</i> <i>conditions of contract or equivalent, or similar positions under</i> <i>similar IFI contract conditions, in the period of eight years</i> <i>immediately before the tender submission deadline"</i> ? Namely, we find this requirement as a discriminatory one, since it is clear from the Scope of the Project that Supervision will be provided under conditions of <b>FIDIC RED Book, First Edition 1999</b> which implies that relevant expert's experience <i>under FIDIC</i> <i>conditions of contract or equivalent, or similar positions under</i> <i>similar IFI contract conditions</i> is relevant not only in the last <b>eight years</b> but in the last 23 years considering that FIDIC RED Book didn't have additional editions for the Construction Contract in the meantime?
