The International Bank for Reconstruction and Development (IBRD) launched the Multiphase Programmatic Approach (MPA) to support the Government of Serbia in the continuation of institutional, physical and operational modernization of the railway sector in an integrated manner by providing financial support to Serbia Railway Sector Modernization Project as part of the Multiphase Programmatic Approach to be implemented in three overlapping phases over the ten year period.

For the purpose of financing Serbia Railway Sector Modernization Project, Phase 1 of the MPA, IBRD and the Agence Francaise de Développement (AFD), jointly, granted to the Republic of Serbia EUR 102 million loan to support enhancing the efficiency and safety of existing railway assets and improving governance and institutional capacity of the railway sector.

Principle responsibilities

The OHS Specialist of the PIU will be responsible for the following duties:

- Check programs and procedures on workplace health and safety designed by the selected Contractor(s);
- Recommend measures to help protect workers from potentially hazardous work methods, processes, or materials. Analyze risks, potential impacts of sub-projects and, based on WB policies requirements (including WB EHSG and GIIP) and national legislation, provide relevant input to E&S Instruments;
- Perform OHS supervision and inspect and evaluate workplace environments, equipment, and practices to ensure that they follow safety standards and government regulations, and WB policy requirements;
- In case of serious incidents and accidents, inform the Bank within 72h and be responsible
 for preparing the complete report and investigating root cause analysis of incidents and
 accidents to identify what caused them and how they might be prevented. Prepare
 preliminary reports and Root Cause Analysis Report when required;
- Investigate complaints and inspect facilities/sites to ensure that they comply with legislation and regulations;
- Regularly deliver OHS training at construction site to contractors, workers, and supervision

- Recommend suspension of activities that pose threats to workers' health or safety. In case
 of incompliances, record and log incompliances and propose corrective measures. Monitor
 implementation of corrective measures;
- In the case of failure to implement corrective measures and in the case of significant incompliance, the PHS Consultant can stop activities until safety for workers is reestablished;
- Monitor the handling of hazardous materials or wastes;
- Assist the Head of the PIU in preparing the regular implementation Reports (site-specific compliance reports as well as semi-annual progress report) to World Bank and other investors;
- Close cooperation with Environmental and Social Specialists and other PIU staff to be selected for support to implementation of the Project;
- Any other OHS-related task to the Consultant's area of expertise as assigned by the Head of the PIU.

In order to be selected, the Consultant must possess, at the minimum, the following qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in occupational health and safety (OHS) or a related scientific or technical field. Advanced degree will be an advantage;
- Minimum 10 years of general professional experience;
- Minimum 5 years of experience in organizing and managing occupational health and safety at large construction sites;
- Certificate on professional exam on safety and health at work and certificate for fire protection;
- Previous experience with IFI or EU projects will be advantage;
- Experience working in construction/transport sector will be advantage;
- Fluency in Serbian and English language
- Computer skills: Word, Excel.

It is expected that the period over which the consultant shall provide the Services will be 30 months, respectively by the end of the project dated December 31, 2026. The assignment is part-time, and it is estimated that total input of the Consultant will be up to 300 days over the Contract period (up to 12 days per month). The Consultant should be available to commence no later than one month after the contract signature. The Consultant shall not be engaged more than 48 hours per week cumulatively for this assignment plus any other additional assignments/contracts.
